

Proof of Entry level requirements

The PEcon courses build on prior knowledge in core areas, which is generally attained by a competitive Master's degree programme in Economics and Finance. Applicants therefore need to prove entry level knowledge in the main fields which are relevant to their desired specialisation. If the submitted information or the material covered in similar Master courses taken at home university is considered to be insufficient, then the student will have to take these additional courses.
